Roughly equidistant to Stayner, Creemore and Collingwood, this facility, at over 8000 square feet, is the largest of its kind within the township, making it the ideal location for your next buck-and-doe, wedding, birthday party, anniversary celebration, Christmas gathering or family reunion.

The lower floor includes a modern kitchen with stoves, fridges, sinks, tableware and a spacious dining hall easily accommodating 100. Adjacent to the dining hall is an enclosed 2-lane bowling alley with automatic pin-setting equipment.
