### **Nottawa Hall to Receive More Parking**

Council received report PCR-013-2019, 4135 County Road 124 Demolition and approved the tender submitted by Kostick Demolition to demolish the existing structures located at 4135 County Road 124, Nottawa.

The demolition is the first step towards creating extra parking for residents and patrons of the Nottawa Memorial Hall.

### **Recreational & Culture Facilities Booking Software**

Council approved the proposal submitted by RecDesk for Facilities Booking Software.

The software was included in the 2019 operational budget and is part of the Strategic Plan to develop recreational programming that is tailored to the needs and desires of the community with the goal of increasing usage and participation.

RecDesk facilitates online registration and reservations.

### **Stop Signs at Milltown Road in Singhampton**

Council approved By-law 19-79 to provide for the erection of two stop signs at the intersection of Milltown Road & Church Street in Singhampton.

### **Formation of Trails Advisory Committee**

Council Approved a Notice of Motion brought forward by Councillor Ed Christie to form a Trails Advisory Committee.
