### **Concession 10 Reconstruction Phase 2 Tender Result & Award**

Council awarded the tender for Phase 2 of the Concession 10 Reconstruction project to Arnill Construction Limited (o/a Seeley and Arnill Construction) in the amount of \$3,471,611.98.

The work includes reconstruction of road base, storm drainage upgrades, slope stabilization, and landscaping improvements. It also includes the removal of existing infrastructure, asphalt surfacing, and installation of culverts, environmental and erosion controls.

### **By-law 23-33 Collingwood General & Marine Hospital Foundation Funding Agreement**

Council authorized By-law 23-33 authorizing entering into a funding agreement with Collingwood General & Marine Hospital (CGMH) Foundation for aquatic programs. The Clearview Youth Centre successfully received funding from CGMH's Foundation through the Wellness Innovation Fund. The Township will be awarded \$5,600 to support the advanced aquatic programs for youth at the Stayner Pool and to provide free admission to open swims to local Clearview youth.
