### On-Street Patio & Retail Display Policy

Council approved the On-Street Patio & Retail Display policy. The policy was reviewed by Staff and the Accessibility Advisory Committee in 2023 and has been revised to maintain accessibility and AODA compliance, and to ensure the safety of pedestrians, workers, and traffic.

Most notably, patios must ensure there is an unobstructed path of travel to the patio from the sidewalk and patios will only be permitted within the on-street parking stall directly adjacent to the property.

### Purchase Portable Washrooms

Council approved purchasing two Mobilio 2, 16-foot trailers with two stations from NIU Smart Toilet in the amount of \$108,000 plus HST. They provide a universal and fully AODA compliant stall. One will be located at the Nottawa Ball Park and one in Stayner.

Council also approved adding \$22,400 to Parks and Recreation 2024 operational expenses for janitorial and waste removal expenses.
