RJ Burnside: Creemore Water & Wastewater Master Servicing Plan

Jeff Langlois, Senior Vice-President Water and Wastewater at R.J. Burnside presented an update on the preferred alternatives determined by the study:

- to expand the existing groundwater drinking water system and;
- expand the current Wastewater treatment plant with a new pumping station and sanitary sewers.

Council endorsed the preferred solutions and implementation strategies identified in the Creemore Master Servicing Plan and

Stayner Siskins Special Rental Agreement

Council approved the Stayner Arena Special Rental Agreement #2. The Stayner Siskins will pay the Prime Rate and receive annual Township funding through economic development or community assistance for promotion and awareness, which will be outlined in a separate Agreement.

Councillor Beelen – Request Replacement of Stop Signs on 3/4 Sideroad at Concessions 9 & 7

Council approved replacing the stop signs at both intersections with larger (4 ft) illuminated or flashing stop signs, to be funded through the Public Works Capital budget for Traffic Control Equipment.
