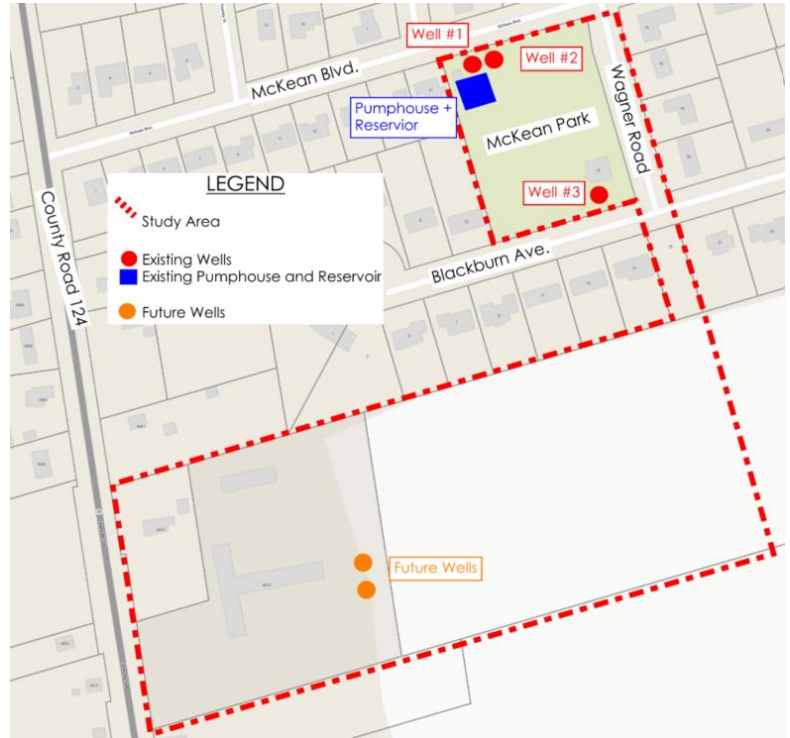
Water Treatment and Supply Expansion for Nottawa

The Study

Georgian Communities is undertaking an investigation to upgrade the existing Nottawa Municipal Water System by expanding or replacing the existing water treatment plant and adding two (2) additional municipal supply wells to the existing system. Please see map insert showing the existing Nottawa water infrastructure.

As a result, a Schedule 'C' Class Environmental Assessment (EA) under the Municipal Class EA process has been initiated to identify a solution for this water servicing expansion. Georgian Communities will be the proponent of the study with the Township of Clearview a key stakeholder.

As part of the Study, online and in-person public and technical agency consultation will be arranged to allow local residents and interested members of the public the first opportunity to review and comment on the study process. It is anticipated that two Public Information Centres (PIC) will be provided during the study.

To ensure that those interested in this study have an opportunity to provide input to and receive feedback from the study team, PIC #1 will be held as outlined below. This first PIC will be an "open house" format and present study background information, the various solutions considered, evaluation of the alternative solutions, selection of the recommended solutions, and next steps in the study process.
