Subject: PW-001-2025 – Speed Reduction – Warrington Road

Recommendation

Be It Resolved that Council of the Township of Clearview hereby receive report PW-001-2025 (Speed Reduction – Warrington Road) dated February 10, 2025; and,

- 1) That Council approve reducing the speed limit on Warrington Road from 80 km/hr to 50 km/hr from Centreline Road to 21/22 Sideroad Nottawasaga; and,
- 2) That a speed reduction by-law be presented at the February 10th, 2025, Regular Council meeting.

Background

In June 2024, Council approved a speed reduction on Centreline Road from 80 km/h to 60 km/h from 500 metres South of Warrington Road to Highway 26, the speed was reduced in conjunction with the development of the former rail line from Stayner to Angus into a multiuse trail.

Comments and Analysis

Currently, the speed limit on Warrington Road is 80 km/h from Centreline Road to 21/22 Sideroad Nottawasaga and then 50km/h from 21/22 Sideroad Nottawasaga to Superior Street (within the settlement area of Stayner).

Staff are recommending reducing the speed on Warrington Road to make the speed in the area of Warrington Road & Centreline Road more consistent and predictable.

Financial Implications

The Public Works Operating budget for signs and signals has sufficient funds for the cost of the signs for these speed reductions.
