Community Improvement Plan

Council approved a staff report recommending that Community Improvement Grants be awarded to nine Clearview Township businesses for façade and streetscape improvements. In total 20 applications were received within the first intake period. The successful businesses will work with the Township to complete the proposed improvements within the next 12 months. Additional details regarding future intake periods will be posted on the Clearview website.

Pre-Servicing Agreement

Council approved a pre-servicing agreement for the Zancor Homes Subdivision and the Apen Ridge II Subdivision. The pre-servicing Agreement allows for the construction of works to commence prior to Final Approval for the plan of subdivision.

RFP- Downtown Improvement Plan

Council approved a RFP submitted by Stefan Bollinger Associates Inc. Landscape Architects in the amount of \$24,337.50 for the Downtown Open Spaces Improvement Plan. The RFP is to identify, prioritize and provide an implementation strategy for the phased improvement of Station Park and Gideon Street within Stayner.

Budget Input to Staff

Members of Council submitted comments and budget suggestions to staff for consideration for the 2018 – 2022 budget. Staff will report back to Council with a list of all budget suggestions.

NVCA Request of Support

Council supported a request from the NVCA for financial support to develop an Integrated Watershed Management Plan. If project funding is approved by the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, the plan will replace the existing watershed management plan which was developed more than 20 years ago.
