### **Nottawasaga Station Phase 1 Subdivision Agreement**

Council approved the Subdivision Agreement with MacPherson Builders pertaining to lands fronting onto Mowat Street in Stayner.

The Nottawasaga Station Phase 1 plan of subdivision includes 72 single detached dwelling units, two future development blocks, including one for the Jarlette Continuum of Care Campus, and stormwater management facilities.

### **Clearview Fire Department Muscular Dystrophy Toll Gate**

Approval was given by Council to Clearview Fire and Emergency Services to hold a toll gate in support of Muscular Dystrophy.

During 2017 and 2018 Clearview Firefighters raised \$18,268.93. They hope to continue to add to that total in 2019.

The Toll Gate will be positioned on County Road 124 in Singhampton between Milltown Road and the Osprey/Clearview Townline on Saturday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 from 9:00 AM until 3:00 PM.

### **By-Law Enforcement Review**

Council has directed staff to take a proactive enforcement approach to enforcing Municipal By-laws.

This will provide Clearview By-Law Enforcement Officers with an opportunity to get ahead of some situations and deter future by-law infractions.

As part of this direction, enforcement hours will be changing, priority enforcement campaigns will be carried out each calendar year and Request for Proposals will be issued for pound and animal control services.

### **Evening & Weekend Enforcement**

Customer service and enforcement hours will be increased to include evening and weekend coverage.

### **Priority Enforcement**

Priority enforcement will begin with staff focusing on property standards and clean yard and waste by-laws.

### **Animal Control**

A Request for Proposals (RFP) for pound services will be issued in October, and an RFP for Animal Control services will be issued at the beginning of 2020
