### **Sale of 201 Huron Street**

Council declared 201 Huron Street, the current Stayner Branch of the Clearview Public Library, as surplus to the needs of the Township and directed staff to acquire three proposals from certified real estate brokerages within Clearview Township. ### **Support for the Royal Canadian Legion's 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of World War 2 Dinner**

Jim Selli, Past President of the Royal Canadian Legion, Stayner Branch, presented to Council asking for support for the November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 dinner. Council approved the request by donating \$1,645.00 towards the event.

### **New Treasurer Appointed**

Council passed By-law 19-90 to appoint Kelly McDonald Municipal Treasurer of the Township of Clearview. A 13-year employee of Clearview, Kelly's work-ethic and dedication to Clearview Township will continue to enhance the Finance and Information Services Department.

### **Modernization Fund Projects**

In the Spring of 2019, the Province of Ontario announced that Clearview Township would be receiving \$676,935.00 as part of the province's modernization fund.

Council approved 14 projects within the 2019 budget year and reserved \$160,000 for the 2020 budget year.

A diverse range of projects have been included which will improve customer service, accessibility, and technology.

The approved projects are:

1. Online building permits
2. Council Chambers streaming/voting technology
3. Scan network to arena/library
4. Online dog tags
5. Audible traffic symbols
6. Pop-up Library System
7. Perpetual fire permits
8. Dash cams for plow and fire trucks
9. Transnomis Allport GPS Routing system
10. Trimble Android device (rugged utility data collector for Public Works)
11. ArcGis utility network management
12. Drone mapping system
13. Citywide maintenance and system
14. Fire Truck iPads
