The second intake of the Rural Ontario Development Program is now open! Small brick and mortar businesses in rural Ontario with 1 to 20 employees can apply through the business development stream. This stream offers up to 35% cost-share, to a maximum of \$10,000. This funding helps small businesses by funding projects that:

- build capacity to attract, retain and expand businesses
- better position rural businesses to attract or retain investment
- support jobs being attracted and retained in rural businesses
