



# Maximum Expenses After Voting Party

Campaign spending limits are established for the 2026 Municipal Election based on the number of electors on the Voters List as of September 15, 2022, as follows:

## Spending Limit for Parties & Expressions of Appreciation

The spending limit for expenses related to holding parties and other expressions of appreciation after the close of voting is calculated as ten percent (10%) of the amount of your maximum campaign expenses.

| Office            | Number of Electors | Preliminary Campaign Expense Amount | 10% of Maximum Campaign Expenses for Parties |
|-------------------|--------------------|-------------------------------------|--|
| Mayor             | 12,854             | \$18,425.90                         | \$1,842.59                                   |
| Deputy Mayor      | 12,854             | \$15,925.90                         | \$1,592.59                                   |
| Councillor Ward 1 | 2,810              | \$7,388.50                          | \$738.85                                     |
| Councillor Ward 2 | 3,237              | \$7,751.45                          | \$775.15                                     |
| Councillor Ward 3 | 2,382              | \$7,024.70                          | \$702.47                                     |
| Councillor Ward 4 | 2,251              | \$6,913.35                          | \$691.34                                     |
| Councillor Ward 5 | 2,174              | \$6,847.90                          | \$684.79                                     |

On or before September 30, 2026, the Clerk shall give a “final” certificate of the maximum campaign expenses to each candidate and third-party advertiser. The number of electors to be used in this final calculation is to be the greater of the number of electors for the office from the Voters’ List as it existed on September 15, 2022, including changes made on that day, or the number of electors for the office from the Voter’s List on September 20, 2026, including changes made on that day.
