Sewage System Permit Inspections

During the course of construction, the Building Inspector must be contacted at the completion of each of the following phases so that the Inspector can make these inspections in accordance with the Building By-Law.

Sewage System Inspections

- 1) Site Assessment: made following receipt of complete application and notice that
(2) two test holes 5 feet deep have been dug in area of proposed leaching bed.
- 2) Final Inspection: when installation is complete but before it is covered, under no circumstances may an installation be covered before the required inspection is made. The contractor must be on site and provide a surveyor's level and rod for inspection
- 3) Occupancy of the Structure: will not be permitted until the complete system has been inspected and the location of the water supply and buildings has been verified.

Requesting Inspections

When requesting inspections, please quote Building Permit Number and allow a minimum of 48 hours' notice.

Inspections may be requested by either dropping into the municipal office or telephoning 428-6230.

Please note that if an inspection is requested prematurely an additional inspection fee may be required.
