

Council Composition and Ward Boundary Review Survey - 2021

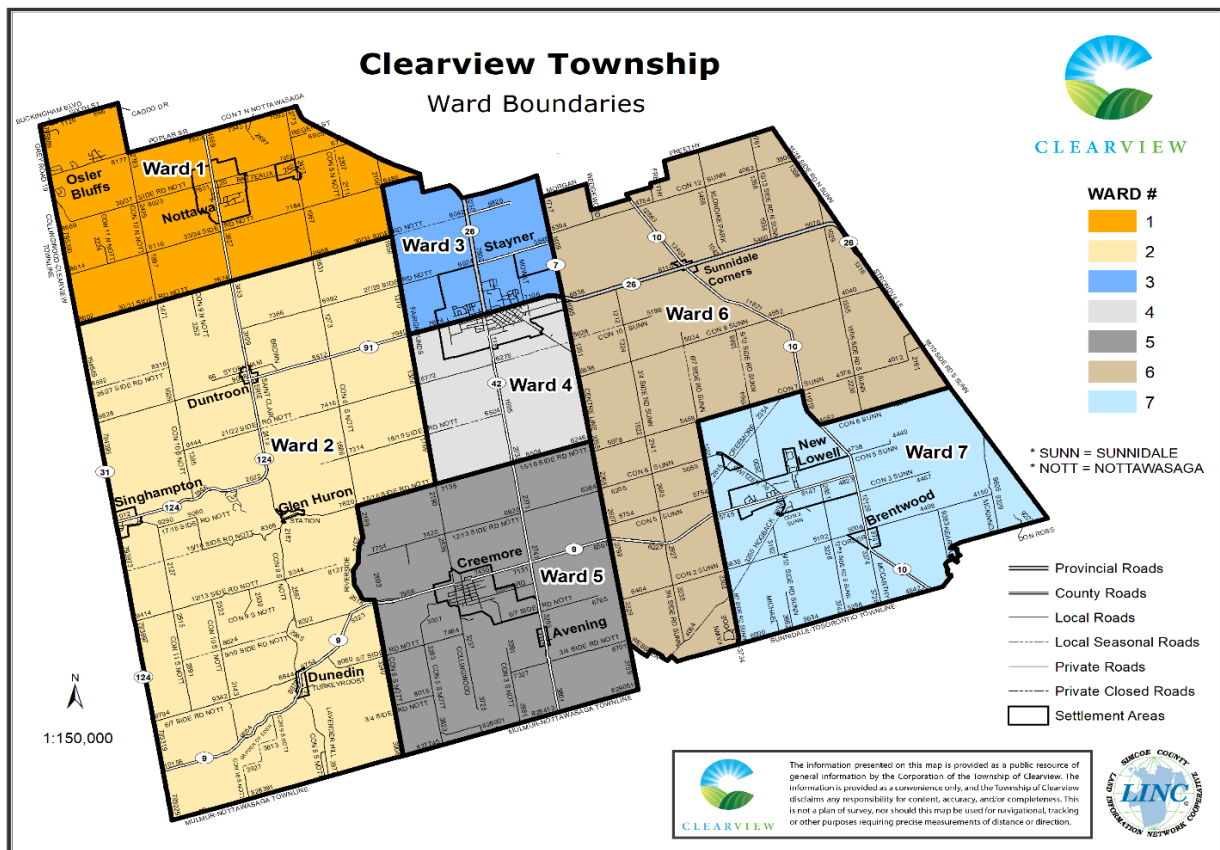
Council is reviewing its composition and ward boundaries to understand if our wards and Council representation is effective, equitable and an accurate reflection of who lives here.

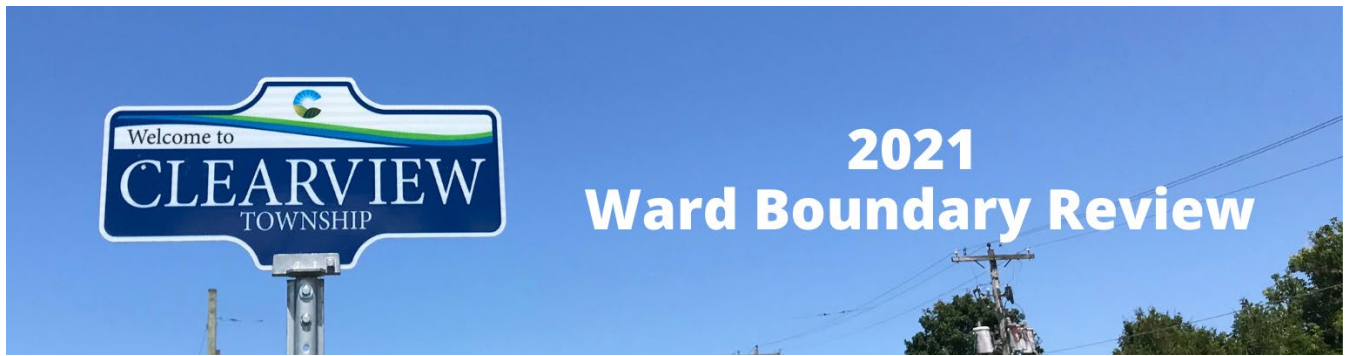
This review will have a lasting impact on how you're represented at the municipal level, now and into the future. We need your help to answer some big questions about how you are represented.

Some information you need to know before taking the survey:

The last ward boundary review was completed in 2013. Council wants to check in with electors prior to the next municipal election and review its current council composition.

What Ward Do You Live In?





What's the difference between voting by Ward and At-Large?

Voting by Ward means, voting for one candidate to represent the area in which you live, in addition to voting for the Mayor and Deputy Mayor positions.

Voting At – Large means, all voters in the Township can vote for all seats up for election (ie: if there are seven (7) councillor positions on council, voters can vote for seven (7) candidates in addition to Mayor and Deputy Mayor)
