### 7.1 Township Bus Service (Specialized Transit)

The Deputy Director of Public Works, Dan Perreault provided background information on the current bus contracts and provided information in moving forward with a potential specialized transit system in partnership with Collingwood and Wasaga Beach.

The Committee discussed the current transit schedule and serviced locations. The Committee provided additional details to consider when developing a more specialized system; minimize bus transfers, minimizing walking distances such as drop off at medical facility entrances, door to door services, etc.

Dan Perreault informed the Committee that ridership is tracked, however; with the pandemic the numbers decreased substantially. Pre-covid saw approximately 13,000 riders per year but accessible uses were not available, Dan will further investigate accessible functions (ramp, etc.) used in the past.

Deputy Director Dan Perreault provided additional information on route expansion in conjunction with new housing developments. The Committee discussed the possibility of a survey and has been encouraged to brainstorm additional specialized transit functions to consider and send suggestions to Dan at [dperreault@clearview.ca](mailto:dperreault@clearview.ca).

Dan Perreault provided information on upcoming sidewalk replacements and expansions and discussed areas of concern with the Committee.
