Recommendation #1 – Riverside Drive/Concession 6:

Be It Resolved that Council hereby approves reducing the speed limit on Riverside Drive/Concession 6 from 70km/hr to 60 km/hr from County Road 9 to the 15/16 Sideroad to address horizontal alignment constraints; and,

That the costs associated with reducing the speed limit be considered during the 2022 budget deliberations; and,

That pending budget approval, staff be directed to present a by-law reducing the speed limit.

Recommendation #2 – Fairgrounds Road:

Be It Resolved that Council hereby approves reducing the speed limit on Fairgrounds Road from 80km/hr to 60 km/hr from County Road 9 to the town limits to address vertical alignment and cross section constraints for multi-modal travel; and,

That the costs associated with reducing the speed limit be considered during the 2022 budget deliberations; and,

That pending budget approval, staff be directed to present a by-law reducing the speed limit.

Recommendation #3 – Concession 10 Nottawasaga:

Be It Resolved that Council hereby approves reducing the speed limit on Concession 10 Nottawasaga from 80km/hr to 60 km/hr from County Road 124 to the town limits to address vertical alignment and cross section constraints for multi-modal travel; and,

That the costs associated with reducing the speed limit be considered during the 2022 budget deliberations; and,

That pending budget approval, staff be directed to present a by-law reducing the speed limit.

Recommendation #4 – 2022 Road Considerations:

Be It Resolved that Council hereby supports prioritizing the following roads in 2022 based on the approved budget for the year, to implement recommendations from the Township’s Transportation Assessment Study:

- Hogback Road (speed reduction)
- Concession 5 Nottawasaga (speed reduction)
- 36/37 Sideroad (speed reduction)
- Lavender Hill Road (speed reduction)
- Klondike Park Road & Concession 12 (intersection review)
- Sunnidale Tosorontio Townline (further road study)
- Warrington Road (further road study); and,

That Council be given the opportunity to provide further direction in 2022 on these roads.

Recommendation #5 – 2022 Line Painting:

Be It Resolved that Council hereby supports prioritizing line painting in 2022 for adding yellow centre lines and white edge lines on Township roads; and,

That Council will consider the costs to increase to the line painting budget during the 2022 budget deliberations to complete the proposed work.

Recommendation #6 – 2022 Develop Complete Streets Policy & Design:

Be It Resolved that Council hereby supports developing a Complete Streets Policy & Design in 2022 when updating the Township’s Engineering Design Standards; and,
That Council will consider the costs to develop this policy and design during the 2022 budget deliberations.

Recommendation #7 – 2022 Develop Rural Road Design:

Be It Resolved that Council hereby supports developing rural road design specifications with requirements for multi-modal travel for future paving projects; and,
That Council will consider the costs to develop these specifications during the 2022 budget deliberations.

Be It Resolved, that By-Law 21-99 being a by-law to confirm the proceedings of the October 5th, 2021 Council Meeting, be presented and read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 5th day of October, 2021.
