Stayner & District Kinsmen Club – Funding Request for Music, Market & Park It

Council supported the recommendation from the Economic Development Advisory Committee granting the funding request from the Stayner & District Kinsmen Club to provide music entertainment at this year's Music, Market & Park It.

Council approved providing funding for the music portion in the amount of \$10,000 from the Economic Development fund.

No Parking Zone Concession 10 North of County Road 124

Council approved the staff recommendation that No Parking zones be implemented on the East side of Concession 10, from County Road 124 to 175m north, and on the West side of Concession 10, from County Road 124 to 50m north.

A By-law will be presented to Council for consideration at the April 25th meeting.

Hybrid In Person Council Meetings

Council supported moving to hybrid in person Council meetings once appropriate infrastructure and protective equipment (plexiglass) has been installed in the Council Chambers.

Council also supported Township
Committees and Boards moving to full inperson meetings following Township and
Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit
guidelines, with the option for individual
Committees and Boards to choose if they
would like to remain virtual for as long as
the state of emergency remains.
