County Education Bursary Program

Council agreed to contribute \$1,000 of support to Simcoe County's Education Bursary program. The bursaries are available to County of Simcoe students attending a post-secondary institution in Ontario. Clearview's contribution will be supplemented with \$2,000 from the County ensuring that a Clearview student will receive a \$3,000 education bursary.

Speed Limit Reduction – Hogback Road & Concession 2, New Lowell

Council passed By-Law 21-41 reducing the speed limit from 80 km/h to 60km/h for 500 meters in all four directions from the intersection at Hogback Road and Concession 2 in New Lowell.

The speed reduction is a safety recommendation from Clearview's Traffic Engineer accompanying the installation of a four-way stop. Work on the intersection will be completed this summer.

Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) Appointed

Council passed By-Law 21-34 appointing John Ferguson as CAO for the Township of Clearview.

Renaming of Hillard Street to Brock Street, Stayner

By-Law 21-37 was passed by Clearview Council renaming Hillard Street in Stayner to Brock Street.

Deputy Fire Chief Appointed

Council passed By-Law 21-43 appointing Scott Davison as Clearview Township's Deputy Fire Chief.
