COVID-19 Community Assistance Fund Established

Council approved the establishment of a COVID-19 Community Assistance Grant fund (CCAG), designed to react to community needs in the recovery of social services, or non-profit organizations in the wake of the Pandemic. The fund will initially see \$10,000 and can receive public donations which Council committed to match dollar for dollar up to an additional amount of \$10,000. Council will receive recommendations from the CCAG committee in the form of a report to Council and decisions to provide all grants will be voted on by Council.

COVID-19 Tourism Support Plan

Council supported a staff report to provide support for the Clearview business and tourism sector throughout the crisis and during recovery after the pandemic.

Ball Park LED Light Replacements

Council approved a report to enhance the ball parks LED lights replacement project to include all three ball parks in Clearview Township. Taking advantage of Save on Energy rebates, replacement LED lights will be purchased for the New Lowell, Nottawa and Ives Park Baseball Parks.

Tax Penalties & Interest Waived

Council voted to waive the penalties and interest on taxes beginning with the March 2020 billing cycle and lasting until the COVID-19 Response is over.
