Stayner Arena Ice Resurfacer & Lobby Flooring

Council approved the quotation submitted by Resurface Corp. for the Olympia Millennium E battery operated ice resurfacer for the Stayner Arena, following the Government of Canada's best practices for improving air quality in arenas and their commitment to reduce the carbon footprint in our communities.

Council also approved the quotation submitted by Dean's Flooring One for the installation of specialized Triumph rubber tiles, resolving the seasonal moisture issue.

Stayner Sand Building RFP Award

Council awarded the Request for Proposal for the Stayner Sand Building project to Van Pelt Construction Incorporated.

The building will be constructed prior to the 2022/23 winter season.

Declaration of Climate Crisis

Council supported the Notice of Motion, officially declaring a Climate Crisis in Clearview Township to deepen the municipalities commitment to protecting the economy, community, and eco-systems from climate change.

Council has directed staff to

1. Consider appointing a Climate Action Committee.
2. Investigate Clearview's potential membership in the Federation of Canadian Municipalities Partners for Climate Protection. Providing the Township with support and access to infrastructure funding.
3. Include the Climate Crisis in the upcoming Strategic Plan review.
