Foodbank Donation of Support

Council unanimously approved a resolution to donate \$10,000 to the Clearview Stayner Food Bank from the Community Assistance Grant. This donation will support the growing need for the Food Bank during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Building Permits & Inspections, Planning, Code and By-law Enforcement Automation System

Council voted to award the contract for the Building Permits & Inspections, Planning, Code and By-law Enforcement Automation System to CityView.

CityView creates comprehensive permitting and land management solutions. They provide this service to over 250 municipalities across North America.

This software will allow Clearview to operate an on-line permit portal that will provide 24/7 access for residents of Clearview to apply for building permits, book inspections, check permit status, register complaints, apply for Planning applications, make By-law complaints etc.

Estate of Clearview Zoning By-law Amendment

Zoning By-law 20-21 was approved by Council.

The amendment brings the Estate of Clearview development in line with the surrounding residential zoning, allowing secondary suites in single-detached Nottawasaga Station dwellings.

Municipal Pound Services

Council voted to enter into a contract with the Alliston & District Humane Society for Pound Services.
