Architectural Control Plan for Residential Infill Lots

Council received report CS-024-2019 and approved the passing of By-law 19-35 to adopt an Architectural Control Plan for residential infill lots.

In accordance with the Township's Official Plan, the Architectural Control Plan sets simple minimum standards on residential lots that abut subdivision developments so that neighbouring properties are in visual harmony with one another and the character of the neighbourhood is maintained.

It applies to properties within the settlements of Stayner, Creemore, New Lowell, Nottawa, Avening, Batteaux, Brentwood, Dunedin, Duntroon, Glen Huron, Nottawa, Old Sunnidale, Singhampton and Sunnidale Corners. Proposed dwellings at least 20 meters away from a side lot line will be exempt.

Fire Chief Appointed

By-law 19-39 was passed by Council appointing Roree Payment as the Fire Chief of Clearview Township Fire and Emergency Services.

Stayner Granite Club (Curling Rink) AODA Upgrades

Council has directed Parks, Culture and Recreation Staff to work with the Stayner Granite Club as they pursue funding opportunities, such as grants, and fundraising initiatives to upgrade the Stayner Granite Club.

The updates are being made to bring the facility into compliance with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA).

Council also approved, in principle, the decision of the Stayner Granite Club Construction to Committee to proceed with Option #3 from Report PCR-004-2019.

New Lowell & Clearview Meadows Site Plan Approvals

Site Plan approvals were granted conditionally by Council on technical engineering issues being addressed for both the New Lowell Central Elementary School Parking Lot Expansion and the Clearview Meadows Elementary School addition.
