Crime Stoppers Flag Raising & Proclamation Request

Council supported a request from Whitney Walsh, Vice President of Crime Stoppers Simcoe Dufferin Muskoka to proclaim the month of January as Crime Stoppers Month and to raise the Crime Stoppers flag at the Clearview Emergency Hub and Fire Administration Centre to raise awareness for the remainder of January.

Extension of Virtual Council, Board and Committee Meetings

Council supported the recommendation to continue with virtual Council, Board and Committee Meetings for an additional four-month period based on the regulations and recommendations from Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit.

Staff will continually review the feasibility of returning to in-person and/or hybrid meetings and provide a follow-up report to Council in May.

Collingwood Street Bridge

Council received report PW-002-2022 Collingwood St Bridge / 6/7 Sideroad Options Detailed Estimate and directed staff to begin engineering and permit approval for the full replacement of the Collingwood Street bridge with a 34-metre span bridge.

Funds for engineering and permits can be budgeted for in 2022/23 from the Bridge Reserve. It is expected that the bridge construction would take place in 2024.

Considerations for Permitting Shipping/Storage Containers

Council directed staff to enforce the current Zoning By-law, prohibiting shipping/storage containers that do not have a building permit in any zone of the Township, prioritizing enforcement on properties that:

1. Have more than one container
 2. Have a container not being used as an accessory to a permitted legal use
 3. Are unsightly or causing a nuisance
 4. Do not meet the setbacks for an accessory building
 5. Are zoned Residential
