Creemore Baseball Team – Request for Waiver of Diamond Fees

Council approved the Creemore Baseball Team's request to have 2021 diamond fees waived. The request was made by Marc Dupuis, Senior Team Rep., and Junior Team Manager to fund the purchase of team t-shirts for their rushed season while they await delivery of the new team jerseys.

Purchase of New Replacement Transit Bus

Council approved the purchase of a new 2021 Elkhart Coach ECII from Overland Custom Coach (2007) Inc.

The current bus obtained through a cooperative purchase process from the Town of Wasaga Beach in 2017 is now close to the end of its life and is requiring more maintenance than it has in the past.
