Building Permit Fee Reduction Request – Habitat for Humanity

Council approved a 100% decrease in building permit fees, for Habitat for Humanity of South Georgian Bay for their single-family home project located at 219 John Street in Stayner. This decrease will be funded from the tax stabilization reserve.

Request for Community Assistance Grant Creemore Baseball (North Dufferin)

Council approved a Community Assistance Grant in the amount of \$3,000 for Creemore Baseball (North Dufferin) to replace approximately 60 jerseys due to rebranding.
