Zoning By-law Amendment 11323 County Road 10 Dog Kennel

Council approved a Zoning By-law amendment to zone a portion of the 11323 County Road 10 from Agricultural (AG) to Agricultural Boarding Kennel Exception (AGK-5).

Creemore Hydro Pole Assessment

An assessment completed by Runge Engineering concluded that the existing EPCOR owned hydro poles in Creemore will not support winter decorations, banners or hanging flower baskets. Council authorized staff to work toward alternatives for downtown beautification initiatives for Creemore other than attachments to the Hydro Poles.

Oslerbrook Zoning By-law Amendment

Council approved an amendment to rezone a 2.25 ha portion of 2634 Concession 10 North Nottawasaga, Oslerbrook Golf and Country Club, from a Commercial Recreation Lands (RECC) Zone to a Rural (RU) Zone.

By-law Department 2020 Bi-Annual Report

Council received the By-law Department's 2020 Bi-Annual Report detailing the number and type of complaints received from January to June 2020.

In the first half of 2020 the highest number of complaints have been COVID-19 related (238 of the 546 complaints) while the report details a decrease in parking related complaints.

In addition, incidences of illegal dumping from January to June 2020 have cost the Township approximately \$10,000. Read the full report here <http://ow.ly/KGaj50AMGIB>

ATV's on Township Roads

Council directed staff to develop a report and By-law allowing greater access for ATV and Side by Sides on Clearview Township roads, including undeveloped roads, road allowances, and trail systems.
