### **2019 Audited Financial Statements**

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### **Review on Cannabis Production in support of the Interim Control By-law 20-64**

Council received Report CS-014-2021 for information and directed staff to hold a public meeting for a Zoning By-law amendment regarding policies and regulations for Cannabis Operations. The Public Meeting will be announced once it is scheduled.

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### **Traffic Assessment Study**

Council approved the recommendations outlined in the study and directed Staff to call a special meeting to address specific road concerns from Council.

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### **Stayner Pool Summer 2021 Operations**

Council received report PCR-012-2021, Stayner Pool Summer 2021 Operations for information and supported reopening the Stayner Centennial Pool effective July 5, 2021 for limited controlled use, registered programs and swimming lessons only.

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### **Vending By-law 21-26**

Council passed By-law 21-26, to license, regulate and govern temporary sales of merchandise, goods, food, or services from a vehicle or stationary booth/stand. This by-law encompasses the housekeeping amendments to the former by-law that were presented to Council at the May 31st meeting.

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### **Clearview Library Resilient Communities Fund Grant**

The Clearview Public Library's Ontario Trillium Resilient Communities Fund grant application was successful. The \$14,000 grant will be used to equip staff with laptops to improve virtual services and the purchase of equipment to facilitate physically distanced in-person programs.

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
