### **Habitat for Humanity DC and Building Permit Reduction Request**

Council approved a 100% decrease in the Clearview portion of Development Charges (DC) fees, for Habitat for Humanity of South Georgian Bay for their single-family home project located at 219 John Street in Stayner. Council also directed staff to research a 100% reduction of building permit fees, this report will be part of an upcoming Council Agenda.

### **Council Composition and Ward Boundary Review Public Meeting**

A public meeting was held allowing members of the public to comment or speak to the on-going Council Composition and Ward Boundary Review. No members made oral comments, but four written submissions were received. A report will come to the July 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of Clearview Council for a final decision.
