Free Compost & Mulch from Simcoe County

Council approved the Township's participation in Simcoe County's Free Mulch and Compost Distribution Program. After half load restrictions have been lifted staff will pick up 80 m³ of mulch and compost.

The mulch will be offered for free to Clearview residents and will be available for pick up in 2 locations, the Creemore Arena and the Stayner Co-op building. Notice will be posted on Clearview's website and on Twitter when the compost and mulch will be made available.

Purchase of William Sound Portable Counter Loop System to Improve Accessibility for the Hard of Hearing

Council approved the purchase of the William Sound Portable Counter Loop System.

The device accommodates individuals with hearing difficulties by transmitting the spoken word directly to a listener's hearing aid.

It will be used at the Administration Centre's front Counter, in the Council Chambers and at various Committee and Board meetings upon request.

Recreation Facilities Behaviour Policy

Council received and approved the Recreation Facilities Behaviour Policy. The policy deals with bad behavior of users or visitors in Township Recreation Facilities and properties in a 4-stage suspension method. To view the policy, visit:
