### **Reconsideration of Speed Reduction on Various Roads**

Council referred the speed reductions for Concession 10 Nottawasaga, Fairgrounds Road and Riverside Drive/Concession 6 North back to staff to discuss the liability implications with legal counsel and the Township's insurance company.

A report will be brought back to Council no later than June 30, 2022, to outline the liability response.

### **Green Shirt Day for Organ Donor Awareness & Registration: Proclamation & Flag Raising**

Council supported proclaiming the month of April as Organ Donor Awareness and Registration month, and April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022, as Green Shirt Day in honour of the Logan Boulet Effect and to remember the Humboldt Broncos Bus Tragedy. A flag will be raised at the Clearview Fire & Emergency Services Hub.
