2018 Annual Summary Report for Drinking Water Systems

Council received the 2018 Annual Summary Report for Drinking Water Systems. 100% of the drinking water samples collected in Clearview Township in 2018 met or exceeded Ontario's Drinking Water Standards.

2019-2023 Budget Approved

Council received the 2019-2023 Budget Approval report for information and approved the budget with an estimated net tax increase of 2.85%. The Treasurer will prepare the final budget package and Tax Rate By-law for approval at a future Council Meeting.
