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### **Amendment to Fees & Charges By-Law 17-110**

### **Zoning By-law Amendment for Vending and Shipping Containers & Amendment to the Licensing By-law 14-42 (Vending By-law)**

Council directed staff to hold a public meeting on a proposed amendment to By-law 14-42, the Vending By-law, and a proposed amendment the Township Zoning By-law to clarify the intent that temporary vending is not permitted in shipping containers, street and rail cars.

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### **Extension of Integrity Commissioner Contract**

Council approved an extension of the current contract with Principles Integrity as the Township's appointed Integrity Commissioner until December 31, 2023.
