### **The Estates of Clearview Pre-Servicing Agreement**

Council approved By-law 19-52, allowing MacPherson Builders to proceed with pre-servicing construction for phase 1 of the Nottawasaga Station development which maintains frontage on Mowat Street, Highway 26 and County Road 7.

This will include pre-servicing work for 75 single-detached units, construction & extension of an internal roadway as well as construction of sanitary and storm sewers, watermain and preliminary roadworks, earthworks, a temporary stormwater management pond and sediment and erosion controls.

All pre-servicing construction will require final approval by the municipality before being connected to the Municipal System.

### **County Road 42 Watermain Tender**

Council approved the tender submitted by B & J Contracting in the amount of \$5,194,356.50 for the County Road 42 Trunk Watermain replacement from Margaret Street to John Street in Stayner.

### **2019 - 2023 Corporate Budget Update and Adoption**

The amended budget was approved with the same net tax increase of 2.85% as approved on March 4, 2019. Amendments made by Council included allocation of funds for reduced OMPF revenues.

### **Councillors Appointed to the Culture & Sports Hall of Fame Selection Committee**

Councillors Robert Walker, John Broderick and Ed Christie will work with staff to select the award recipients for the 2018 Awards.

### **By-law Enforcement Review**

Council approved a Notice of Motion brought forward by Councilor Walker for staff to review By-law Enforcement services and opportunities for customer service, including a reactive vs. proactive approach. A report will be brought to Council prior to the 2020 budget process.
