Report Speeding Concerns to the OPP for Direct Investigation

Residents with speeding concerns are encouraged by the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) to call 1-888-310-1122 and report those concerns to the OPP directly.

Directly reporting concerns allows the OPP to investigate, enforce speed limits and collect data in problem areas.

Notice of Motion to Recommend Speed Limit Reduction in Traffic Management Study

Council directed staff to include a recommendation to lower speed limits in the upcoming Comprehensive Traffic Management Study.

Interim Control By-law - Industrial lands on Edward Street East

Council decided not to approve the Interim Control By-law at this time.

Canine Control By-law

Council approved the passing of an amendment to Canine Control By-law 01-50 to include the standards of care of canines within the Township of Clearview.

COVID-19 Financial Impact

Council received FIN-005-2020, COVID-19 Financial Impact, report from Treasurer Kelly McDonald for information.

2020 Corporate Budget Adopted

Council unanimously adopted the 2020 Corporate Budget with a net tax increase of 1.04% and directed the Treasurer to prepare the final budget package.

Council also passed By-law 20-35, setting the 2020 tax rates and levy taxes.

Interim Tax By-law Due Dates

Council passed an amendment to By-law 20-08 waiving penalties during the emergency period and setting 2020 tax due dates of April 23rd and June 25th.
