Council approved the 2021-2025 South Georgian Bay and Springwater Community Safety and Well Being plan presented by Karie Warnar from Avail Consulting. The plan takes a multi-sectoral approach to identifying local risks, service gaps, service accessibility and resource sustainability and outlines strategies to allow for a safer, more diverse community that promotes equality and inclusion.
