### **Prescribe Rate of Speed – Concession 10 Nottawasaga**

Council approved By-law 21-112 reducing the rate of speed on a portion of Concession 10 Nottawasaga from 80 km per hour, to 60 km per hour. Construction began on Concession 10 in the summer and is expected to wrap up in early December. Prior to the road reopening, staff is arranging to have the speed signs installed.
