### **Tender Approval for Replacement of Culvert 398-43 21/22 Sideroad**

Council approved the tender submitted by Seeley and Arnill Construction in the amount of \$629,032,73 for the replacement of culvert 398-43 on 21/22 Sideroad east of Concession 6 Nottawasaga.
